**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS
A14 Slip roads between J1 and J2 Electrical Maintenance**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential electrical works to various locations on the slip roads along the A14 between Junction 1 and 2.

During our scheme of work, we will be replacing the bollards and give way signs at the four slip roads at J1 & J2 of the A14. These works are necessary to keep the electrical assets in safe working order and to provide the travelling public with information at the junctions.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and a smoother driving experience.

When will the work take place?

This work is due to start on **08 August 2022** and is scheduled for completion by **End September 2022**.

Please note that all our planned works may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses and road users, we will work in phases under full slip road closures overnight between **8pm** and **6am, Monday to Friday**.

During these closures fully signed diversion routes will be in place, which have been agreed with the Local Authority. All carriageways and slip roads will be open as usual outside of our working hours.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

We will make sure that access to businesses and residents is maintained wherever possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.

Polite request

To lessen overnight disturbances to the communities closest to our work, we politely ask all heavy vehicles to follow our signed diversion routes.
