ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

1. VISION STATEMENT

Moulton Parish Council will work to improve practices, which have a negative environmental influence, in order to promote sustainable development and reduce damage to the environment.

Moulton Parish Council will concentrate on developing:

- an appreciation of environmental values and the impact of human activity
- a basic understanding of environmental issues at both local, regional, national and global levels
- sound environmental practice in managing the home, community and work environment
- local community contributions to solving local, or otherwise, environmental issues

This will be done by:

- ensuring, wherever possible, we purchase services and resources which will do the least damage to the environment
- minimising waste, wherever possible, by recycling and reusing goods/materials and disposing of waste in a responsible manner
- attempting to reduce energy and water consumption and minimise, where possible, pollutants
- promoting conservation and the sustainable use of both non-renewable and renewable resources
- assist, where possible, protecting, conserving and enhancing the built and natural environments
- as appropriate provide information on environmental issues and educate employees in sound environmental practices and procedures
